

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-7-2

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH FEES RELATED WITH THE CONTROL OF ANIMAL AND VEGETABLE FATS, OILS, AND GREASE AND THE PERMITTING OF FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS DISCHARGES.

WHEREAS: the Town of Oliver Springs has adopted an Ordinance to control the discharge of fats, oils, and grease into the sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS: the Town of Oliver Springs will regulate the discharge of fat, oil, and grease through a permit system; and

WHEREAS: those permits shall be issued to Food Service Establishments who's discharge of fat, oil, and grease may interfere with the proper operation and maintenance of the sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS: the use of a permit system will cause the Town to accrue certain costs; and

WHEREAS: it is the desire of the Town of Oliver Springs to these costs be borne by those sanitary system users who's discharge contains animal and vegetable fats, oils, and grease in the amounts which will interfere with the proper operation and maintenance of the sanitary sewer system. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OLIVER SPRINGS, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. Fat, oil, and grease control fees. The town council of Oliver Springs establishes the following fees:

Permit fees: \$35.00- Existing Food Service Establishment with Grease Control Equipment.
\$45.00- Existing Food Service Establishment without Grease Control Equipment.
\$55.00- New Food Service Establishment requiring Grease Control Equipment.
\$35.00- Annual renewal fee for all permitted Food Service Establishments.

Inspection Fees:

First inspection- no charge
First inspection after failing- \$50.00
Second inspection after failing- \$ 75.00
Third inspection after failing- \$100 and mandatory meeting before Water Board.


Maintenance and Cleanup Fees:

Cleanup crew: Three men and truck- \$62.50/hour to 93.75/hour for


overtime wages.
Flusher truck: \$55.00/ hour.
Backhoe/dump truck: \$55.00/hour
Chemicals: billed at the Town's costs
Parts: billed at the Town's costs
Unforeseen costs: billed at the Town's costs

SECTION 2. Date of effect. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the town requiring it.
